

## **NCAA Men's Basketball Regional Advisor**

The NCAA (National Collegiate Athletic Association) is looking for one (1) regional advisor of officiating who will be retained as independent contractors for Division I Men's Basketball, specifically for the West region (includes the states of AK, AZ, CA, CO, ID, MT, NM, NV, OR, UT, WA and WY). This individual will serve in an advisory role to the national coordinator of officiating in connection with the selection, assignment and advancement of game officials during the Division I Men's Basketball Championships as well as other officiating matters. This position is a one-year term. The term will begin September 1, 2021 and is paid a modest stipend plus travel and expenses commensurate with responsibilities. The NCAA promotes diversity and minority equity. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.

### **Services:**

- a. Serve in a consultative capacity to the national coordinator of officiating in connection with the selection, assignment and advancement of game officials during the Division I Men's Basketball Championship by attending games in person or by observing leagues/teams on television.
- b. Attend the conference coordinators of officials meeting in September and a regional officiating clinic where the National Coordinator will present to the Division I, II and III conference coordinators of officials and Division I officials, outlining the new rules, points-of-emphasis, mechanics and other officiating matters.
- c. Work regularly with the National Coordinator and Division I conference coordinators of officials, as appropriate, to assure the most consistent and effective teaching and communication is being utilized in developing the available "pool" of officials for the Division I tournament.
- d. Monitor and evaluate officials to ensure proper application of the points of emphasis as defined by the NCAA Men's Basketball Rules Committee.
- e. Evaluate regular-season game video and send suggestions/and or video clips to the National Coordinator for the development and enhancement and content of the NCAA officiating website.
- f. Participate in the in-season teleconferences with the conference coordinators of officials and participate in teleconferences with the National Coordinator.
- g. Evaluate and grade officials for advancement during the NCAA tournament (first-/second-/third-rounds via television and regional site in attendance).
- h. Maintain a heightened degree of diligence and awareness regarding any semblance of gambling influence, by or among officials, whether real or perceived, at all times.
- i. Responsible for miscellaneous projects as assigned by the National Coordinator.

**Preferred Qualifications and Minimum Requirements:**

1. Experience in men's college basketball as a coach, administrator, officiating coordinator or official.
2. Ability to work with little or no supervision, quickly and under pressure.
3. Ability to balance multiple tasks.
4. Excellent written and oral communications skills.
5. Demonstrated leadership and interpersonal skills.
6. Extensive knowledge of NCAA men's basketball rules and officiating mechanics and techniques.
7. Ability to use electronic mail as a means of correspondence.
8. Ability to use computer technology as a means of education. (i.e. using DVSPORT or Synergy and other video analysis tools to provide teaching and training video clips to the National Coordinator)
9. Shall not be an active coach, official or Division I conference coordinator of officials.
